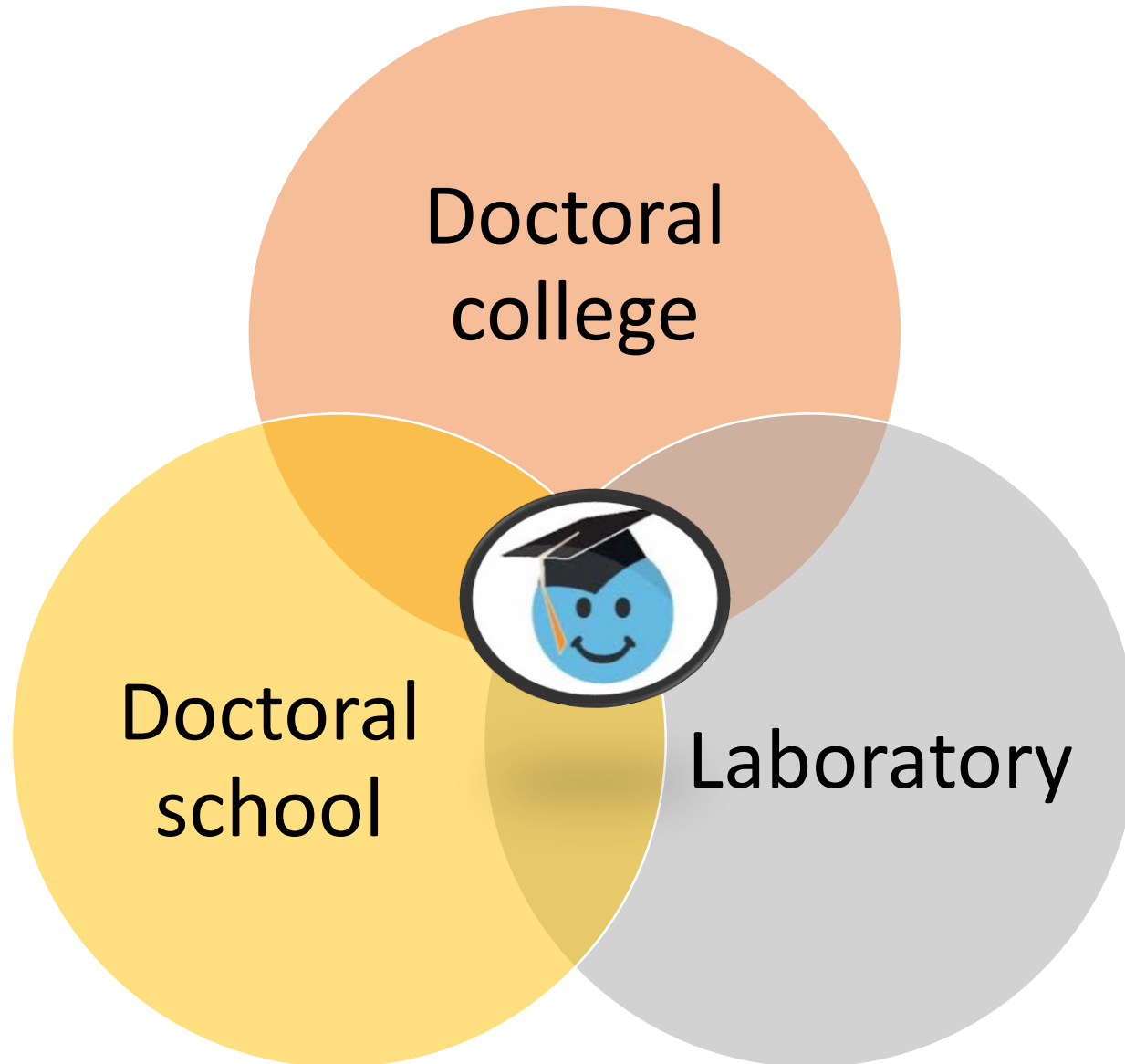

1. Roles and responsibilities

The Doctoral College and the Doctoral School:

- Ensures good financial, material and environmental conditions
- Contributes to the scientific exchanges between the DS laboratories and external researchers (conferences, mobility)
- Provides a training program
- Promotes and follows the professional integration of the PhD students

The laboratory director :

- Contributes to the scientific and material integration of the PhD student
- Is the referent person for the organization of the thesis committees (comité de suivi de thèse)
- Is the first person to contact in case of conflict

2. Roles and responsibilities

The supervisors :

- Define the objectives and work schedule
- Supervise the thesis work of the PhD student
- Organize regular meetings
- Ensure the dissemination of the research results
- Are concerned with the professional career of the PhD student

The PhD student :

- Implements all the means required to complete the thesis project
- Regularly informs his/her supervisors of the research results and possible difficulties
- Produces written documents (laboratory notebook, reports...)
- Follows the training courses proposed by the Doctoral College

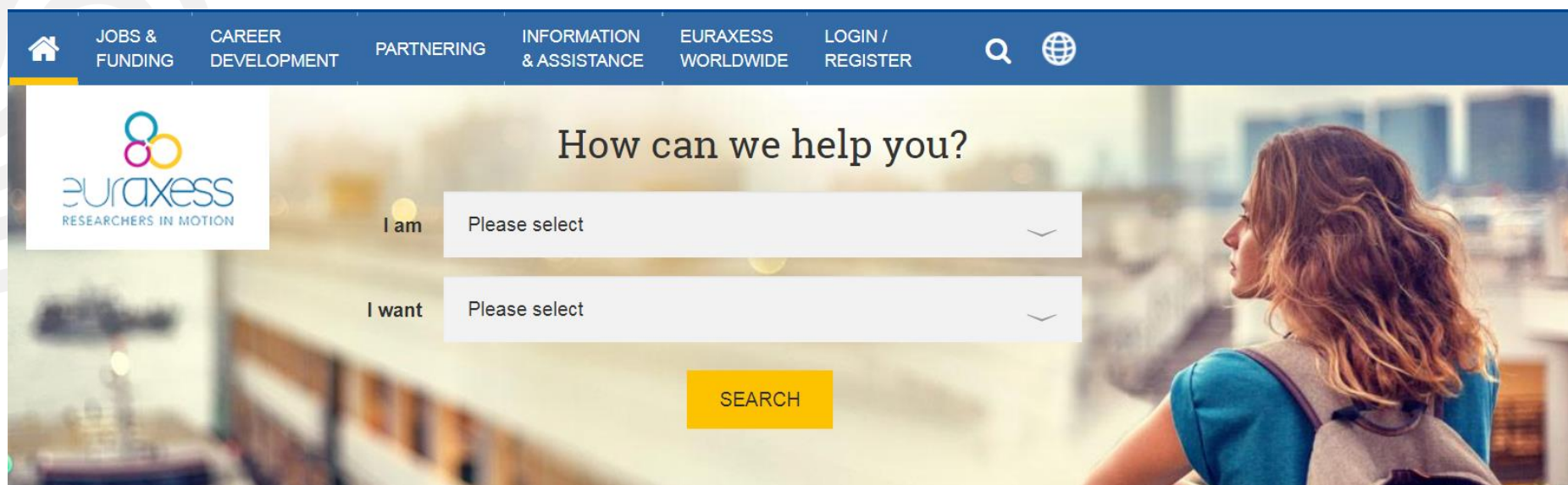

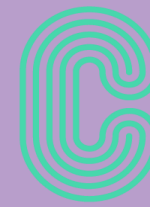

Health Service

Dr. Montuclard: full time doctor at the university

- 80% Occupational physician: legal obligation for the employer and employees
- 20% University Health Service

The University Health Service and the Occupational Medicine Service are only dedicated on prevention (they don't deliver care or prescription)

All doctoral students are students: they benefit from the services of the University Medical Service (SSU):

- Adaptation of study and working conditions for the disabled
- Medical orientation
- Psychology consultation (one of them speaks English fluently)
- Preventions consultations: I will systematically offer you a consultation (possible in English)

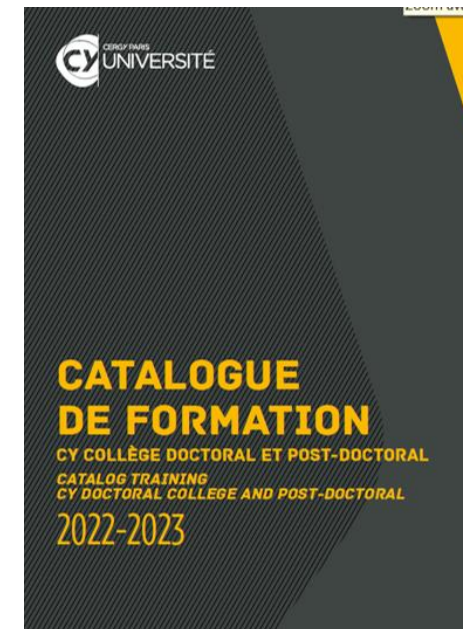
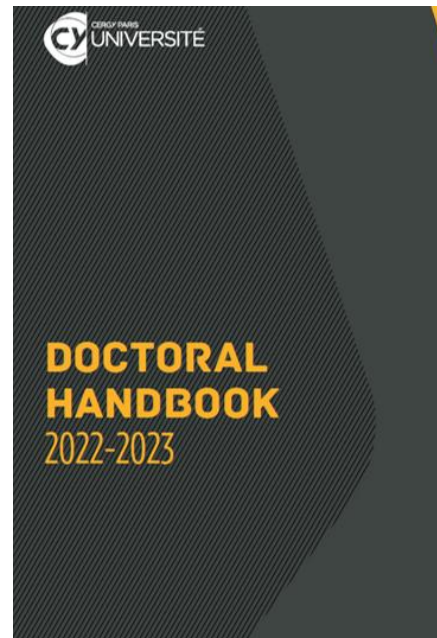

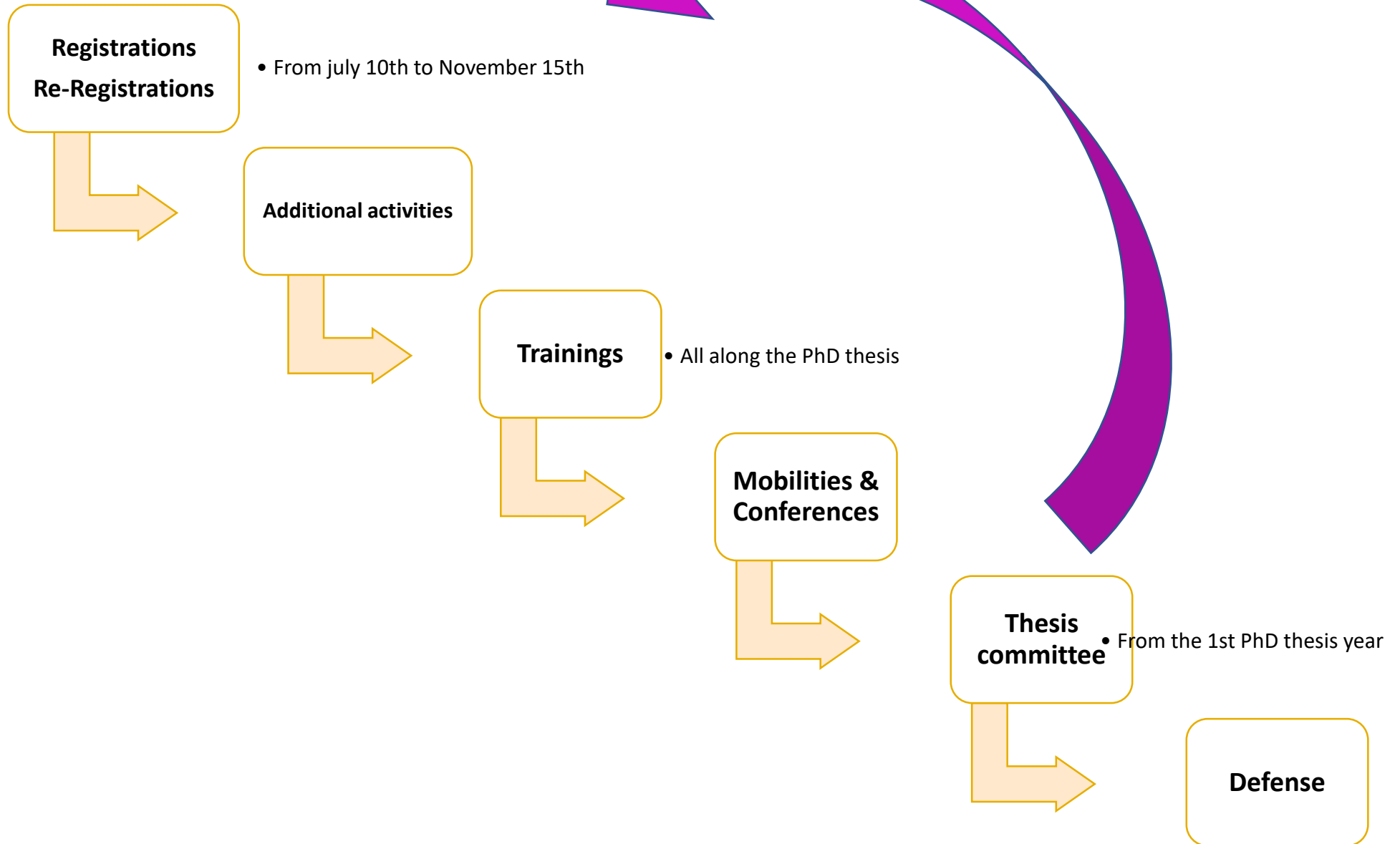

2.The key steps of doctoral studies



What changes for 2023 ?

-> *Order of August 26, 2022 modifies the order of May 25, 2016*

- **Thesis Progress Committee =**

ensures the smooth running of the student's progress by overseeing:

- the training conditions for PhD students,
- the progress of their research,
- and by preventing or putting an end to any form of conflict, discrimination or harassment.

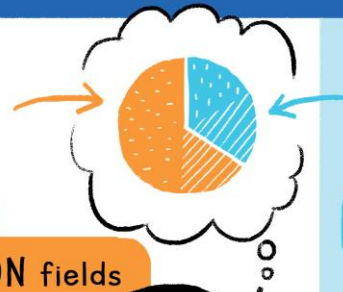
Who ? At least one member of CY who does is not involved in supervising the thesis and one member external of the research field.

When ? The thesis progress committee must meet before the student enrolls for the 2nd year, and every year after that.

- **Commitment of doctoral students and PhD Graduates to respect the rules of ethics and scientific integrity through :**
 - The first registration **by signing the doctoral charter** and the 2021 decree on scientific integrity which concerns everyone in the laboratories.
 - During the defense of these, after the jury's deliberation, the PhD Graduates **takes an oath** (in French or in English).

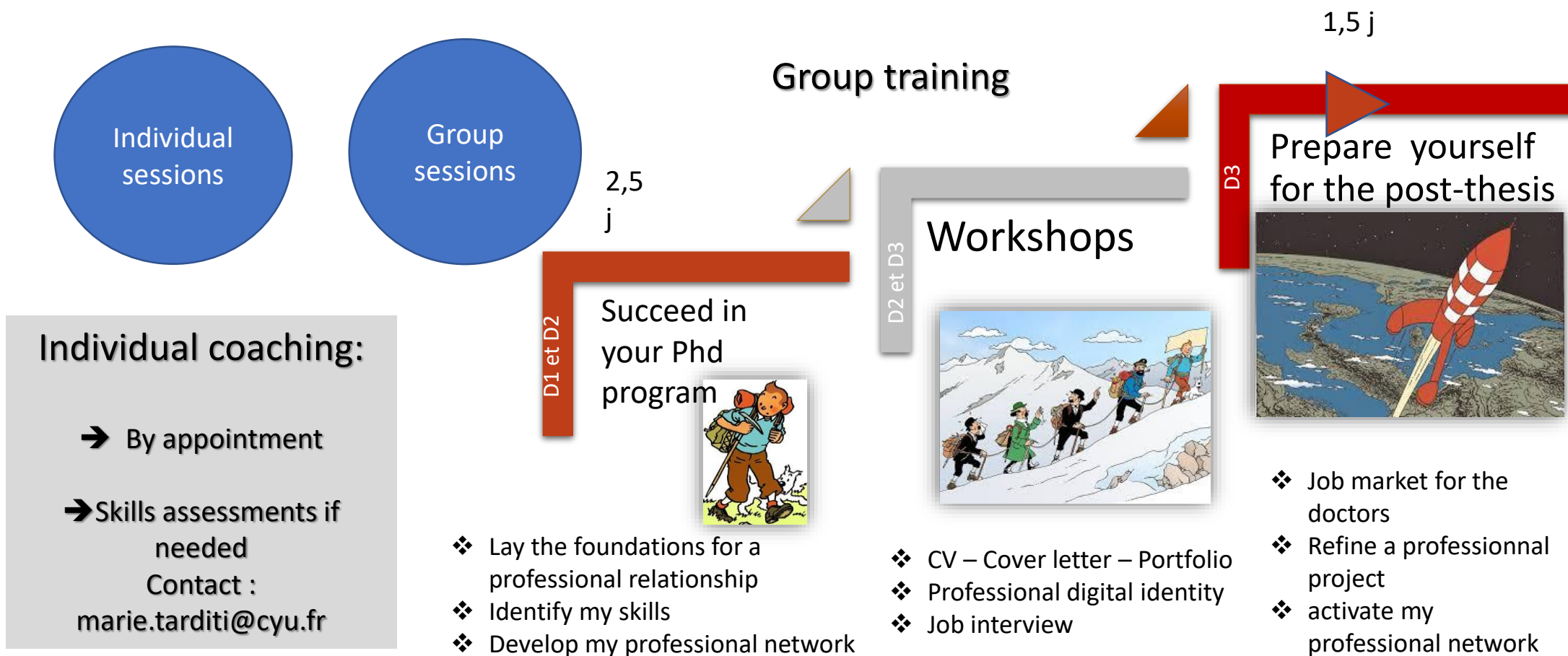

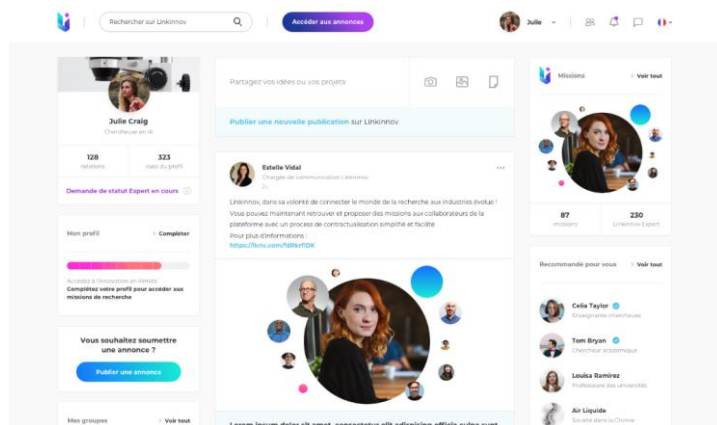

SCIENTIFIC INTEGRITY: WHAT AND WHAT FOR?

Scientific integrity is part of professional ethics, in the sense that it is part of a code of good conduct

Breaches of scientific integrity disqualify the researcher, penalize the community

Moral obligation for higher education and research institutions and element of strategy that involve a necessary collective awareness and sharing of issues

Every researcher must aim for scientific integrity

***MOVE FROM THE INDIVIDUAL AND COLLECTIVE UNCONSCIOUS
TO INDIVIDUAL AND COLLECTIVE CONSCIOUSNESS***

THE MEANING OF WORDS

- **SCIENTIFIC INTEGRITY**

- Rules governing the practice of research
- Code of professional conduct which must not be violated
- Consubstantial of any research activity, it is on its respect that knowing and knowledge are based,
- *Scientific integrity cannot be discussed*

- **ETHICS of research**

- Research ethics deals more broadly with the major questions raised by the progress of science and their societal repercussions
- It is really at the heart of the relationship between science and society
- This is the consciousness of science
- *Ethical issues can be debated*

SCIENTIFIC INTEGRITY: A RECENT HISTORY AND STILL UNDER CONSTRUCTION

"Scientific integrity is a moving field, relatively recent, and the structuring of which is in the process of being done"

- **2005: *European charter of researcher***
 - **2007: 1st global conference on scientific integrity (Lisbon)**
 - **2010: Singapore declaration on integrity in research**
 - **2011: first European rules of scientific conduct ("European code") for research integrity. Revision in 2017**
- **IN FRANCE**
 - **2010: ALIX report on strengthening research integrity**
 - **2016: CORVOL report**
 - **2021: OUZOULIAS-HENRIET (French Sénat) report**
- **In France, the Scientific Integrity Referents are organized in network (RESINT) and work with the French Office for scientific integrity (OFIS), an HCERES department.**

ISSUES OF SCIENTIFIC INTEGRITY

- **"CARDINAL CONCEPTS" (Report from French Sénat 2021):**
 - "Reliability", "respect", "honesty", "responsibility"
 - **MAJOR ISSUES**
- **confidence in science, reliability of research results, probity of the researcher**
- *"Research is a superb profession, practiced with rigor and honesty by the vast majority of researchers. Discovering, inventing, innovating, providing answers to major or apparently futile questions, any new contribution to the body of existing knowledge requires the veracity of the facts reported. This is how the scientific legacy of mankind is built. The public must be able to trust its researchers and experts. A truncated, deviated or falsified truth risks having serious consequences at the societal level and casting a lasting and unfounded suspicion on the very nature of the purposes and the contribution of research" (Corvol, 2016)*

BREACHES AND MISCONDUCTS

- **We can be honest in research without knowing how, but it is better to know which lines should not be crossed!**

There is no official typology. We talk indifferently about fraud, misconduct, breaches of scientific integrity, questionable research practices ...

Nevertheless, we can refer to the following nomenclature:

- Manufacturing, falsification of results et plagiarisme (FFP)
- Questionable research practices (PQR)
- Conflicts of interest
- Signatures of publications

Respect for scientific integrity: an individual and collective responsibility

- **The whole difficulty lies in the proper handling of the offense!**

AWARENESS AND TRAINING IN SCIENTIFIC INTEGRITY

- **" BUILDING A SHARED CULTURE OF SCIENTIFIC INTEGRITY" (French Sénat, 2021)**
 - **TRAINING OF DOCTORAL STUDENTS: AN OBLIGATION**
 - The edict of 25 May 2016 setting the national framework for training and the procedures leading to the issuance of the national doctoral diploma explicitly provides in its article 3 paragraph 3 ° that doctoral schools "ensure that each doctoral student receives training in research ethics and scientific integrity ". This is the first time that the term "scientific integrity" appears in the doctoral curriculum.
 - **TRAINING OF RESEARCHERS AND SUPERVISORS: A STRONG RECOMMANDATION**
- **AWARENESS "BUILDING A RESEARCH ENVIRONMENT FRIENDLY TO SCIENTIFIC INTEGRITY" (French Sénat 2021): A STRONG INCENTIVE**
